

Development may be slow nationally but here in Corby that is certainly not the case as we continue to grow and remain well on track to achieve our ambition of doubling the Borough's population to 100,000 by 2030.

Already since the beginning of 2000 we have built over 6,000 new properties, including over 600 affordable homes - 153 of which are council houses. These affordable figures mean that we are actually out-building most local authorities including the likes of big cities such as Manchester and this is certainly no mean feat during what has been a turbulent global economy.

As well as new homes, we have also been improving the infrastructure of our Borough which has resulted in achievements such as schools in Corby being built, rebuilt or significantly improved, our train station being enhanced by a new dual track that will increase journeys to and from the Borough and our night time economy going from strength to strength due to the investment in the Town Centre through the Core theatre, Corby East Midlands International Pool, Savoy Cinema and surrounding restaurants and bars.

But we are not sitting on our laurels here in Corby, we know there is still more to achieve and this is why Corby Borough Council is continuing to work hard to bring new investment, jobs and training to our area. Most recently Corby Borough Council opened the Corby Innovation Hub on Bangrave Road, which along with its sister site, the Corby Enterprise Centre, focuses on the business community, offering both office and industrial accommodation through quality offices and workshops.


Looking over what has been achieved here in Corby it is not a surprise that our Borough has recently been shortlisted as one of the 3 finalists of the Academy of Urbanism Great Town Award 2018, taking pride of place alongside Milton Keynes and Coventry. To be shortlisted for this award is an acknowledgement of the great amount of vision, investment and partnership working that has gone in to regenerating our Borough. The opening line of the Academy's nomination for Corby wrote:

'Corby is a town being transformed. Corby demonstrates what can be achieved through civic ambition and a commitment to growth and today is the fastest-growing borough outside of London'.

So win or lose, we should take note of what has been achieved here in Corby and be proud of our successes whilst continuing to look forward to our future. Who knows, if we can out build Manchester then why can't we be the next Great Town for 2018?





Corby Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) has been engaging with the people of Corby to find out how aware they are of the challenges facing the NHS locally. We have a limited amount of money to spend and want to make sure we get the best deal for the people of Corby. We also asked people for their views on primary care. Primary care is where most people go to first for healthcare, usually your GP surgery. As a CCG we wanted to strengthen our connections with local support groups, faith groups, charities, the voluntary sector and the organisations we work with to help keep people healthy and happy - such as the local councils and other NHS organisations. To do this we started to build a contact list of the groups and organisations in Corby that are involved in health and wellbeing or represent different areas of this community. So far we have over 250 contacts on this list and we are still adding to it.

Then, in February and March this year we ran a public survey. This was available online and at GP surgeries where the Patient Participation Groups (PPGs) at each of the surgeries asked people to complete the survey. With this valuable support from the PPGs, we received nearly 700 responses. If you were one of the people that took the time to complete the survey, thank you.

We also ran three workshops and invited people from our contact list to attend.

So what did we find out? Many of you (but not all) have concerns about difficulties in getting access to primary care. Most people who responded accepted there needs to be changes to services - however a significant number of people are undecided on this.

Service quality and accessibility where considered the most important criteria that we as a CCG should consider when looking at change.

We were interested to find out that many of you still do not feel that mental health is given enough priority. And you also told us that you want better access to primary care and a wider range of health and wellbeing services to be located in the same place.

More recently the results of the national GP survey have been published, and you can look up how patient from your surgery have responded at https://gp-patient.co.uk/ We will be working with our 5 GP surgeries to understand these results and try to further improve patient care.

As a CCG we will be continuing to listen to the people of Corby to get your views on health services locally. We will be using your feedback and experiences to help us make decisions about these services.

We need to make sure that we look after all the needs of the people of Corby and their carers. This includes physical and mental healthcare, routine and urgent care, maternity services and paediatrics, cancer diagnosis and treatment, preventing future disease and coordinating long term conditions and medication. PROTECT YOURSELF ONLINE: OUR TOP TEN TIPS

If you're new to the internet, or already use it to take advantage of the huge variety of things it can do to make life easier, we'd like to help you to stay safe online.

Here are our top tips to help you to protect yourself, your money, your identity and your devices:

1. Choose, use and protect your **passwords** carefully, and use a different one for every online account in case one is hacked. Don't use a name or dictionary word. Use at least 8 digits, with a mix of upper & lower case letters and numbers, possibly an acronym of a meaningful phrase. Remember, your email, if compromised, could be used to reset all your other passwords – so ensure your email password is strong and unique.

2. Look after your **mobile devices**. Don't leave them unattended in public places, and protect them with a PIN or passcode/fingerprint.

3. Ensure you always have internet security software loaded on computers and a similar app on your mobile devices, kept updated and switched on. Remember that smartphones and tablets can get compromised too. Download software and app updates as soon as possible, they may contain vital security upgrades to keep your device and data safe.

4. Don't assume **Wi-Fi hotspots** in places like cafes or hotels are secure - never use them to do anything confidential, like using your email or making a payment. Instead, use 3G, 4G or a VPN (virtual private network). Ensure your home Wi-Fi has a strong password security code.

5. Never reveal too much personal or financial information in emails, on social networking and dating sites, or in person. You never know who might see it, or use it. Identity theft is increasing. Always dispose of sensitive documents, bills, or addressed letters by shredding or confidential waste. Avoid posting that you are away from home on social media.

6. Take your time and **think twice**. Beware that online or on the phone, **people aren't always who they claim to be**. Fake emails and calls are common ways for fraudsters to approach their victims, so if you're unsure, research them online or call the company using the published number. Remember - if something seems too good to be true, it probably is.

7. Don't click on links in emails, posts, tweets or texts – and don't open attachments if the source isn't 100% known and trustworthy, or if it seems strange you'd be receiving them. Clicking on a bad link could upload malicious software, which could result in data loss, financial loss or even lock you out of your device. Never log onto your online banking or any other site via an email link – fake sites look like the real thing. Always go to your bank or other company's login page by typing their web address into your browser.

8. Never pay for anything by **direct bank transfer** – and never pay for anything via a money transfer service, such as Western Union – unless it's to someone you know personally who is reputable. Remember that credit cards offer greater protection than most other payment methods. Alternatively, use a secure payment site such as PayPal.

9. Regularly back-up your data, securely, to a portable hard drive or online. If your device is lost or compromised, you can then retrieve your essential or irreplaceable information.

Nightlight began in 2013 as a church project run by St Columba's Church in Corby in conjunction with St Jude's, a Kettering based charity, which had been working with homelessness for several years. The original project focussed on helping those who found themselves rough sleeping to survive the coldest winter months. Accommodation was provided in the hall of the Church of the Epiphany hall, which is situated on Elizabeth Street in the town centre. Guests would arrive between 10pm-11pm and receive a hot meal before bedding down for the night on camp beds. They were then woken in the morning and offered breakfast before all the equipment had to be packed away until the shelter opened again that night. Facilities were limited as there were no showers but the shelter provided a great service and managed to prevent many people from freezing to death over the four years it ran.

During the last season it became apparent that the church hall was going to be converted into a gym so Nightlight would have to find a new home. On top of all this, the leader of St Jude's, who had managed the Nightlight project, decided to retire. Thankfully a group of volunteers from the shelter got together and came up with a plan for the future to save the project.

The new independent charity Corby Nightlight was registered on 3 May 2017. A small leased building has now been secured close to the town centre and a new service providing will open on 1st November 2017 providing a 24 hour a day, year round hub facility for homeless adults. Not only will we be providing a place to eat and sleep, we will also have shower and washing facilities for guests to use. The overall aim of the new shelter will be to help people out of the situation they find themselves in, rather than to just keep them alive. Guests at the new will have support to address the issues that led them to be rough sleeping in the first place. This will be done through the positive influence that the project's experienced staff can offer, and links to outside agencies such as the mental health service Mind and substance misuse organisations such as Bridge and S2S. Within the shelter we want to create a community atmosphere in which quests can feel that someone cares for them and has their best interests at heart. The shelter will work with people as individuals to achieve the best outcomes for them and to ensure they have the best future possible.

There are many ways that local people can get involved and support us to change homelessness in Corby and surrounding areas. The most important thing that we need is volunteers to work at the new centre. Do you have 4 hours of free time a fortnight? We will be holding volunteer information events on Saturday 9th September at 2pm and Wednesday 20th September at 7.30pm at the Hazel Tree pub on Greenhill Rise. We are also looking for people to collect tinned food and toiletries for us, and for people to join our meal rota. Could you help us by cooking a meal for 12 people once a fortnight? There are more details about volunteering on our website

We have also recently won £10,000 of building materials from Jewson in their Building Better Communitites award. We are hoping to get the keys to our new building on 1st September and we'd love to hear from trades people or anyone that loves DIY who would be willing to give up a few hours to help us transform our new building.


