TEAM BUILDING OPPORTUNITY

Corby Woodland Project has now welcomed in the new coppicing season in Hazel and Thoroughsale Woods in Corby. Coppicing is a traditional method of woodland management that has been practised for over 1000 years to regenerate woodland and provide fuel and materials for many crafts. Young tree stems are cut down to near ground level to encourage the development of new, vigorous shoots.

This is a fantastic opportunity to dedicate some time to reconnect your team after the past year. The sessions take place in a beautiful ancient woodland and will motivate your team to work together, develop their strengths, encouraging collaboration rather than competition.

In turn, you will be supporting the continued improvement of a unique piece of history.

All equipment and risk assessments will be included, and you will be provided with a tool's safety brief upon arrival by our Parks and Woodland Ranger. We ask that your team provide their own gloves.

Team building is available Monday - Fridays during October 2021 - March 2022 - please note these are subject to staff availability. Please provide at least two possible dates.

Half day sessions are available:

10am - 1pm or 1.30pm - 4pm

Up to 20 people.

As the Lord-Lieutenant I am the Queen's representative in the County and my first and foremost duty is to uphold the dignity of the Crown. This is very much a non-political role and I take my lead from the example of The Queen and other members of the Royal Family to promote a good atmosphere and spirit of co-operation across the County.

My formal duties include arranging and hosting visits by the Royal Family to the County, representing the Queen locally and performing duties with the armed services, both the regulars, reserves and the cadet organisations and other uniformed organisations. This links back to the origins of the role, in the reign of Henry VIII, when the Lord-Lieutenant was responsible for the maintenance of order and the provision of all military measures necessary locally for defence.

One of the main roles is to promote, validate and in some instances present honours to individuals and organisations, typically including the presentation of British Empire Medals, the Queen's Award for Enterprise and the Queen's Award for Voluntary Service. The Lord-Lieutenant is also the senior magistrate in the County.

Beyond these formals duties I am very involved in providing links across different elements of our community – whether civic, enterprise, social or community. It allows me the opportunity to shine the light on the wonderful work that typically goes unseen. This has been so evident during the last two years as we have coped with the impact of COVID.

The Lieutenancy is also involved in promoting the County both internally and externally working with the North Northants Council and West Northants Council.

In this role I am supported by 35 Deputies who are very much the eyes and ears of the Lieutenancy. They provide a vital insight into many areas across the County as well as being able to stand in for me on occasions where I am unable to attend.

The position is one of great privilege that gives access to all corners of our society and allows me to encourage and support individuals and groups in their many endeavours.



Coughs, Colds and Sore Throats in Children



Coughs, colds and sore throats are very common in young children and are to be expected at this time of year. Many of the young children in the UK did not have as many infections last year due to Covid restrictions and have started to experience winter infections such as bronchiolitis a little earlier this year. Many of the things we have been doing over the last 20 months to prevent Covid will also protect us against other viral infections during this coming winter. This means all of us continuing to wash our hands regularly, using a tissue to catch coughs or sneezes and washing your hands afterwards, and staying away from others if you or your household are feeling unwell.

For the majority of children, these illnesses will not be serious and they will soon recover following rest and plenty of fluids. Most children will not need antibiotics for these conditions. Make sure that you have a thermometer in your home for checking for fever and that it is suitable for the ages of the children living with you, a pharmacist can help you to decide which thermometer to buy. Please remember to buy some simple remedies from the pharmacy such as liquid paracetamol to have at home to treat these common illnesses.

Fever associated with common, simple viral infections such as a cold typically rises and falls over a total of 12-48 hours. Children often complain of feeling cold at the start of a fever. They may feel shivery, although they will feel hot and dry to the touch. Later they often say they feel hot, and will be sweaty and flushed. Make sure that you also remember to arrange a Covid PCR test (by calling 119) for your child if they are unwell with a fever or any respiratory symptoms, a lateral flow test is not accurate enough to test for Covid in people who have symptoms.

Children under two are at risk of more severe infections from common seasonal illnesses including bronchiolitis. Fever in babies aged 3-6 months has a higher chance of being serious, and you should seek medical advice if the temperature is 39°C or more in this age-group. Fever in a baby aged less than 3 months is unusual and is more worrying, you should seek medical advice if the temperature is 38°C or more in this age-group.

Other signs that may suggest more severe infection in a child of any age and that indicate that you need to seek more advice for an infection include:

- -a child who is pale or who has mottled skin
- -a child who does not respond normally or who cannot wake up
- -a child who has difficulty breathing especially if the skin is being sucked in between each rib on every breath or if they have grunting when breathing
- -a child who is unable to feed normally due to breathing difficulties or coughing
- -a child who is not passing the normal amount of urine
- -a child who has a dry mouth, tongue or lips
- -a child who has a rash that doesn't fade if you put pressure on it or who has neck stiffness (call 999 if you notice this since the child may have meningitis)

It is not necessary to go to A&E departments if children have simple coughs, sore throats and colds. For very young children and babies, you can call the health visitors at the 0-19 Hub on 0800 170 7055 (option 4), Monday to Friday between 8am and 5pm or the Weekend Health Visitor helpline between 8.30am and 12.30pm on 07598 235094 if you have any concerns about feeding and minor illnesses. You can also seek advice using NHS 111, talk to a Pharmacist, or contact your GP surgery. If your child needs to be examined the health professional might direct you to attend a site that is not your own GP surgery, especially if it is overnight or at the weekend.



This last year has been extremely detrimental for the wellbeing of many older and vulnerable people within our community, there has been crisis, enforced isolation, fear and restriction, dominated by Covid-19 pandemic risks.

To support the needs of our community Lakelands focussed on maintaining as many of its services as it could whilst still remaining within government guidelines, the hospice day care and transport provision was suspended, and a system of telephone contact and doorstep deliveries was implemented by our nursing team who rotated furlough cover to provide this service throughout.

We maintained our **Hospice** @ **Home** services, throughout the whole of the covid year, providing ninety patients and their families with this valuable service. Special mention must go to our team of dedicated **H@H** nurses and coordinators for maintaining this service under severe PPE constraints and covid risk conditions to provide vital end of life care in the home to the patients referred to us.

Community fundraising was decimated by the pandemic with all but a very small number of on-line events being cancelled. As a community hospice historically funded by the generosity and support from its local population this was particularly challenging.

The Day Hospice has been undergoing a phased reopening since May 2021. All staff and volunteers are PCR tested weekly with patient numbers gradually being increased as safely and securely as possible, to date we have incurred zero positive covid cases which is testament to the dedicated leadership of our nurse manager Tracy Glen.

Additional support services such as patient activities, bereavement counselling and Carer support group meetings are planned to be reinstated later in the year.

Lakelands would like to thank the wonderful team of staff and volunteers who have steadfastly worked through the pandemic and who have worked above and beyond the usual expectations throughout the last eighteen months.

As a hospice funded by its community we need you now more than ever, we are slowly and safely returning to our annual community events and hope in the new year to be back upto a full calendar. However the effects of the pandemic have hit Lakelands hard like so many others. Please keep supporting your local hospice, your support goes directly to help your family, friends neighbours in our wonderful community.







EAST MIDLANDS KNIFE AMNESTY

East Midlands Knife Amnesty was formed back in 2019 with the intention of trying to reduce the rate of knife related crimes in our community. I became quite concerned about how many knife related incidents were occurring in our streets, particularly within young groups of people but only them. Knife crime was becoming a normal occurrence in Northamptonshire and I felt the need to do something about it, especially when me and my partner discovered we were expecting our first child, I wanted our children to grow up in a safer environment than what we live in now.

The amnesty started off just me on my own, raising awareness online and around the town where I live about knife related incidents and crimes that were happening on our doorsteps, I also helped to arrange a walk through the town centre to raise awareness of the problems we were facing in regards to knife crime.

I also conducted knife sweeps around the town, especially in areas of the town that were well known for violent/knife related activity and I started arranging weapon collections via our Facebook page and our Amnesty phone, I would receive messages from people from all over Northamptonshire who had weapons in their possession and wanted me to collect them, as the police at the time were not ready to start accepting weapons being handed in by the public, unless they suspected the weapon had been used in a crime. I am happy to say that is not the case now, my fellow volunteers and I have managed to forge a professional relationship with the police department in Northamptonshire and now work very closely with them to ensure that any weapons handed in to us are transported and stored safely and securely so as to cause no further harm to us or our community.




